The school sought a refresh for its 70-year old facilities (& some new ones) in 2015, the project team found in MRM's Saflok700 the perfect brand to exemplify their school motto; "seeking the highest"! In this, the new flagship structure was a sports hall for indoor disciplines whose arching Saflok roof cover was laid in single, site-processed lengths on a mega-vault that is at once both functional and aspirational.
