### Making a world of difference through health and education

The Safal MRM Foundation (formerly the MRM-EIB Trust) was set up in 2002. Its vision is, "To promote advancement of public health and education in order to alleviate poverty."

It has since established two initiatives: the Mabati Medical Centre (MMC), which offers primary health care, and the Mabati Technical Training Institute (MTTI), which offers vocational training.

At MMC, Ksh350 covers consultation, treatment and any medicines stocked at the clinic. In conjunction with the Ministry of Health, the centre immunizes babies at no cost. Specialist eye, dental and diagnostics services have been made available to avoid the long and tiresome journey from Mariakani to Mombasa.

MTTI has an average pass rate of 95 per cent for all the national exams that are taken. Systems are in place to ensure the students gain work experience as part of their training. Over 70 per cent of the alumni are in full-time employment or run own businesses.

The foundation has impacted the lives of thousands of Kenyans. It aims to ensure that the services are sustainable and continue to

be available for many years to come. Funding over the years continues to come from MRM Ltd and the larger Safal Group, which set up these initiatives as a true manifestation of their vision, "To make a world of difference".

Funding has also come from several sponsors who continue to walk alongside the foundation to make the good work possible. It is not possible to list them all here, but for their generosity, the Board of trustees and the Mariakani community in general, are truly grateful.

To ensure that services are accessible, fees have to be subsidised and kept low. The foundation welcomes support from well-wishers. A contribution of Ksh50 ensures one of the 700 students at MTTI gets a meal and is not on the street being a menace to society. A contribution of Ksh750 covers the cost of a chest X-ray. You can support the foundation to empower Mariakani youth through MTTI and keep communities as healthy as possible to fend for themselves.

Together with the foundation, you can create lasting solutions to the challenges of health and education.
